The EGALURG network was established with the aim of improving emergency healthcare. By encouraging cross-border cooperation, the project aims to guarantee equal access to this service for all people on both sides of the Pyrenees.

Providing healthcare in emergency situations along the 700 km of the Pyrenees mountains is very difficult due to the highly abrupt geography. The main goal of the EGALURG Project is to overcome these barriers by creating a cooperative operating network with the different emergency healthcare systems in this cross-border region.

Strategic approach:

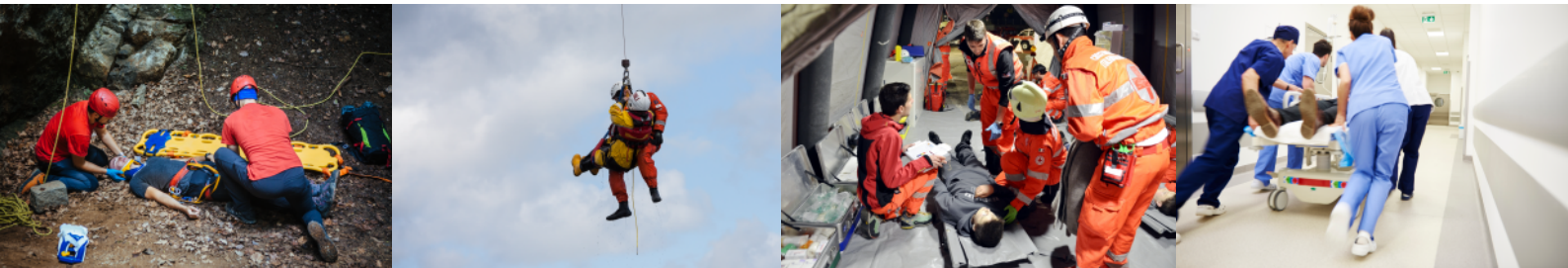
- It is a **scientific and human initiative based on solidarity**.

- It was created because of the need to **update** healthcare in emergency and disaster situations through innovative protocols.

- To develop **innovative healthcare techniques** to respond to emergency and disaster situations.
